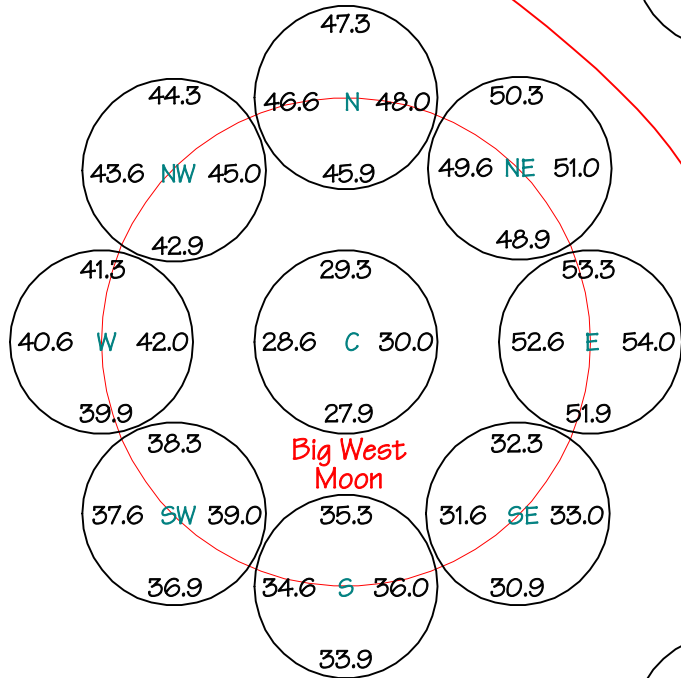


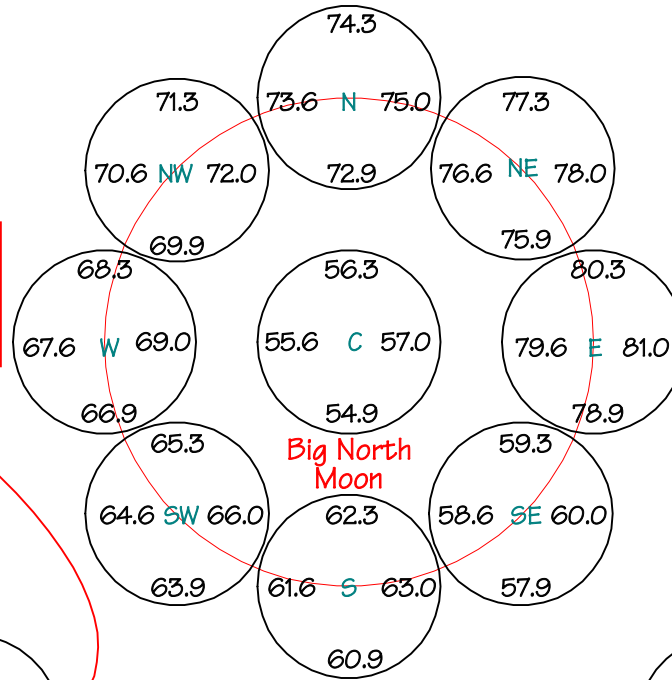
Honoring the Chaotic Journey

 SE = Self Concepts / Attitude & Approach

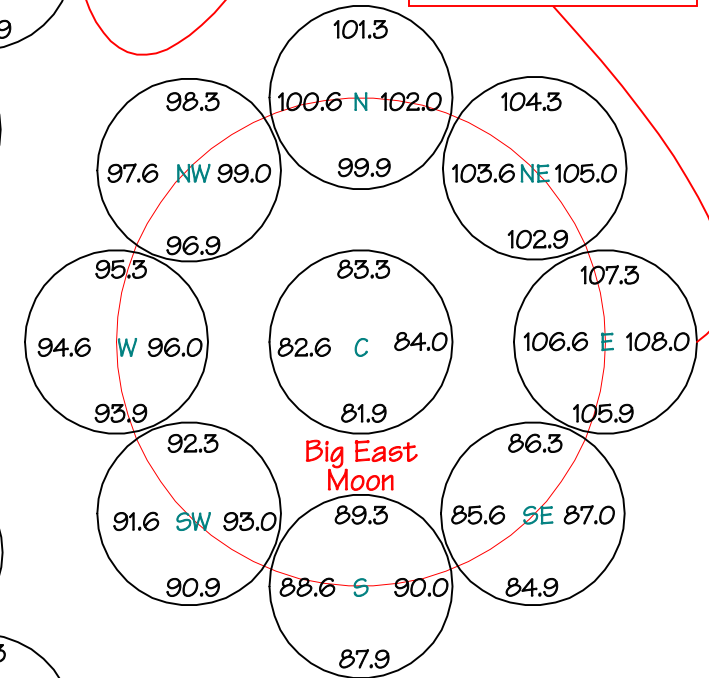


Big North Moon

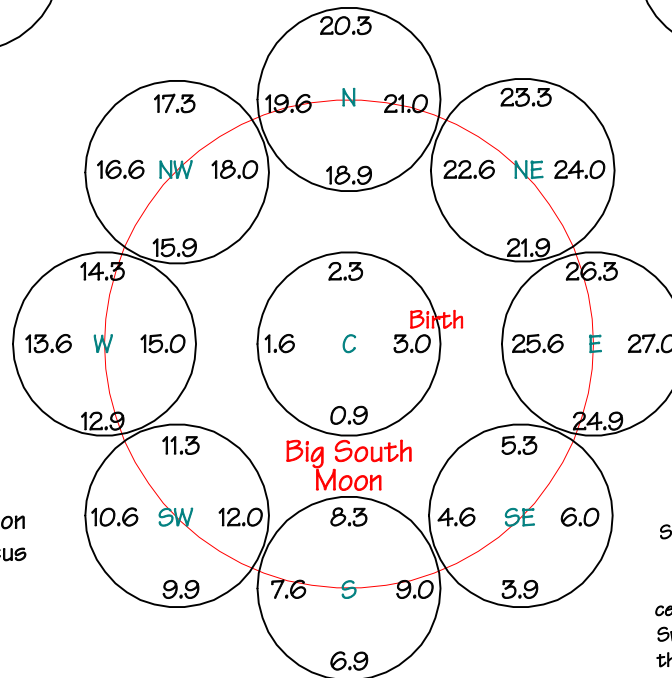
